Events determine how actions are activated in buttons when a document is exported to Adobe PDF. Some event types are as follows. On Release. This event occurs when the mouse button is released after a click. This is the most commonly used event, because it gives the user one last chance to drag the cursor off the button and not activate the action. On Click. This event occurs when the mouse button is clicked (without being released). Unless there is a specific reason for using On Click, it is preferable to use On Release so that users have a chance to cancel the action. On Roll Over. This event occurs when the mouse pointer enters the button area defined by the button's bounding box. On Roll Off. This event occurs when the mouse pointer exits the button area. On Focus. This event occurs when the button receives focus, either through a mouse action or pressing the Tab key. On Blur. This event occurs when the focus moves to a different button or form field.

Answer: D is incorrect. View Zoom is an action type used in InDesign.

QUESTION 3

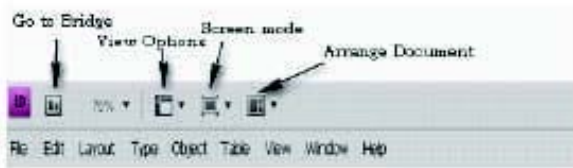
You are working with three open and tabbed documents. You want to view all the three documents simultaneously on your monitor.

The Arrange Document dropdown menu in the Application bar is used to lay out document windows as a grid. The Application bar provides menus and options that make it easy to access the workspace. The Arrange Document dropdown menu is used to quickly arrange open documents in a variety of configurations. Along with this bar, the user can also access Adobe Bridge.



The above figure illustrates the Application bar

Answer option B is incorrect. The Control panel (**Window > Control**) provides quick access to options, commands, and other panels related to the current page item or objects that you select.

Answer option D is incorrect. The Status bar (at the lower left of the document window) shows information about the status of a file and lets you turn to a different page.

Answer option C is incorrect. The Pathfinder panel is used to combine selected objects into new shapes. This panel can be opened by choosing **Window > Object and Layout > Pathfinder**.



QUESTION 5

You are creating a book in InDesign CS5. If you select the Automatic Document Conversion menu option in the book panel's flyout menu, what will happen?

- A. InDesign will convert all chapters into the XML format.
- B. InDesign will convert all pages of the book into the master page.
- C. InDesign will convert all chapters created in the earlier versions of InDesign into the InDesign CS5 format.
- D. InDesign will convert all chapters created in the current version of InDesign into the InDesign's earlier version format.

Correct Answer: C

If the Automatic Document Conversion menu option is selected in the book panel's flyout menu, InDesign converts all chapters created in the earlier versions of InDesign into the InDesign CS5 format.

Answer: B, D, and A are incorrect. These three options are not valid in the given scenario.
