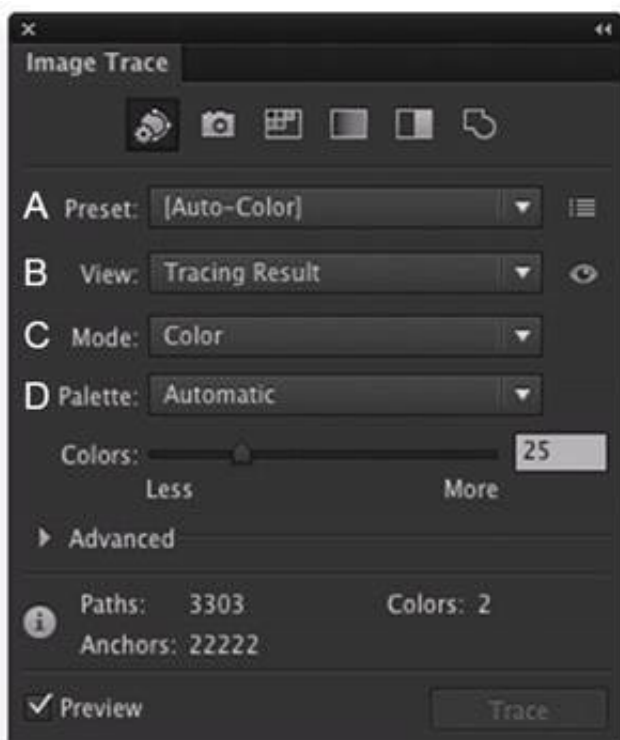
You are designing assets for the user interface of an OS X application, but the type you set in Illustrator doesn't match up well with how type looks in the operating system. How should you adjust the type?

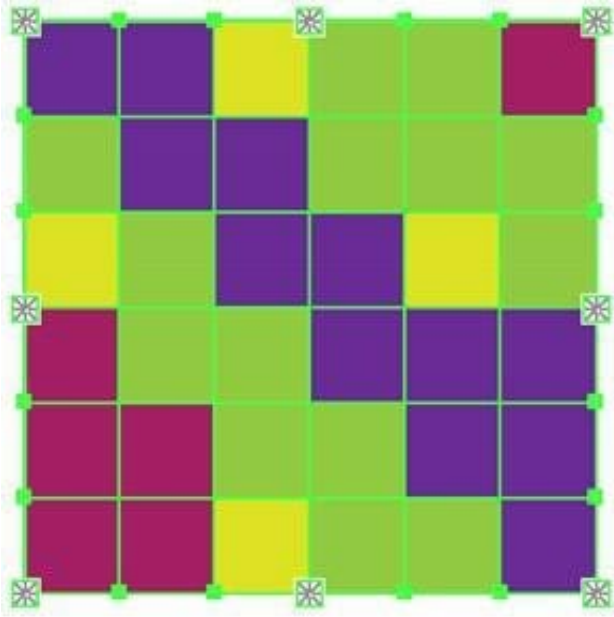
You want to make specific areas of an object partially or completely transparent based on the gray values of a second object placed in front. How should you set up the two objects?
