WUXGA resolution is currently available in high-end LCD televisions and computer monitors. Answer option A is incorrect. XGA stands for eXtended Graphics Array. It is a display standard that refers to video adapters. IBM introduced this display standard in 1990. It is capable of displaying the resolution of 1024 x 768 pixels. Answer option D is incorrect. UXGA stands for Ultra eXtended Graphics Array. It is a display standard that refers to video adapters. This display standard is capable of displaying the resolution of 1600 x 1200 pixels. A UXGA display provides four times more pixels than an 800 x 600 display. Answer option B is incorrect. SXGA stands for Super eXtended Graphics Array. It is a
