You need to ensure that the app is available automatically to users in a specific site collection without requiring the users to install the app.


You create an App Catalog site collection.

Step 1: Upload the app to the App Catalog site.

After you have uploaded the app, you then must add it as an app to the App Catalog site so that it appears on the Site Contents page for the App Catalog itself.

Step 2: From the App Catalog site, go to Settings and then add the app

Step 3: In the Managed Paths sections, configure the site collection.

On the Manage App Deployments page, type the URL for each site collections to which you want to deploy the app, and then click Add to add it to the list.

In the Managed Paths section use the Add button to specify which managed paths should have this app available.

Box 1: EnableGroupCreation

Disable Group Creation.

Box 2: GroupCreationAllowedGroupId

Make an exception for the ITTeam. Only the ITTeam is allowed to create a group.

Box 3: New-MsolSettings

Example: Run this command to create the new template with EnableGroupCreation set to false and pass the group for authorized users who will be able to create groups.

Replace "ENTER GROUP DISPLAY NAME HERE" with the display name of your group to get the ObjectId of the group.

\$group = Get-MsolGroup -All | Where-Object {\$_.DisplayName -eQ "ENTER GROUP DISPLAY NAME HERE"}

\$template = Get-MsolAllSettingTemplate | where-object {\$_.displayname -eQ "Group.Unified"} \$setting =
\$template.CreateSettingsObject()

\$setting["EnableGroupCreation"] = "false"

\$setting["GroupCreationAllowedGroupId"] = \$group.ObjectId New-MsolSettings ettingsObject \$setting
