QUESTION 4



Some bears are attracted to human camping areas for food, which has led to some unfortunate incidents, if in danger expert\\s advice campers to act death.

- A. if in danger experts advise campers to act death.
- B. if in danger experts advise campers to act die.
- C. if in danger experts advise campers to act dying.
- D. if in danger experts advise campers to act dead.
- E. if in danger experts advise campers to act deadly.

Correct Answer: D

This sentence has an error by using a noun `death\\' in the place of an adjective `dead\\'.

Option "if in danger experts advise campers to act death" uses a noun form.

Option "if in danger experts advise campers to act die" uses a verb form (die).

Option "if in danger experts advise campers to act dying" uses a gerund (dying).

Option "if in danger experts advise campers to act deadly" uses an adverb form of the word (deadly) that are in appropriate to the context. Option "if in danger experts advise campers to act dead" uses an adjective form (dead). That is more appropriate than the rest of the options; hence, it is the correct answer.
