**QUESTION 1**

The VMware vCenter Server Appliance has been deployed using default settings.

What user name and password are used to log in to the administration interface to configure the appliance?

- A. The initial user name and password must be supplied on the first login attempt.
- B. The initial user name and password must be supplied during deployment.
- C. The initial user name is root and the password is blank.
- D. The initial user name is root and the password is vmware.

Correct Answer: D

Default user name and password is root and vmware respectively. This is a norm with VMware since they are easy to remember. However, it is advised to change username and password once you are done with installing the vcenter server.

QUESTION 2

What are two reasons why a company would choose to use ESXi 5.x instead of using VMware Workstation 8? (Choose two.)

- A. The company needs to be able to assign existing physical disks to virtual machines.
- B. The company needs remote management of virtual machines
- C. The company needs support for virtual machines with up to sixteen vCPUs
- D. The company wants the lowest overhead possible for the virtual infrastructure.

QUESTION 3

An administrator adds an ESXi 5.x host to the inventory of a vCenter Server that is configured with a vSphere Distributed Switch. The vSphere Web Client indicates that the host is not responding. The administrator determines from the command line that the vpxa agent is stopped. What should the administrator do to resolve this issue without affecting the uptime of the virtual machines running on the host?

- A. Restart the management agents in the host's DCUI
- B. Remove and re-add the host to the vCenter inventory
- C. Restart the vCenter Server service
- D. Type /etc/vmware/vpxa start from the ESXi command line

Correct Answer: A

**QUESTION 4**

A vSphere administrator needs to upgrade a single extent VMFS3 datastore to VMFS5 and expand it to 4TB in size. The storage administrator has already expanded the underlying LUN to 4TB. Which steps should the vSphere administrator take?

- A. Expand the VMFS3 datastore to 4TB and then upgrade to VMFS5
- B. Upgrade the datastore to VMFS5, manually change the partition scheme to GPT, and then expand the datastore to 4TB
- C. Upgrade the datastore to VMFS5 and then expand it to 4TB
- D. Change the block size of the VMFS3 datastore to 1MB, upgrade the datastore to VMFS5, and expand it to 4TB

Correct Answer: C

QUESTION 5

An administrator is performing maintenance on a storage array used by an ESXi 5.x host. The administrator wants to disable alarm actions for the host while the maintenance is taking place. What procedure will accomplish this task?

- A. Go to the Alarms tab for each ESXi host in the DRS cluster. Locate storage-related alarms. Right-click and disable each alarm.
- B. Right-click the DRS cluster and select Alarm and Disable Alarm Actions.
- C. Right-click the ESXi host and select Alarm and Disable Alarm Actions.
- D. Go to the Alarms tab for the Datacenter containing the DRS cluster. Locate the storage-related alarms. Right-click and disable each alarm.

Correct Answer: C
