Correct Answer: B

**QUESTION 4**

Which of the following statements about block level incremental backups (BLIB) is correct?

- A. They enable restore of individual objects for Oracle.
- B. They enable restore of individual objects for Exchange.
- C. They can speed up backups of Oracle databases.
- D. They can speed up backups of Exchange servers.

Correct Answer: C

Block level incremental backups (BLIB) backs up changed data for Oracle. This method does not apply to Exchange.

QUESTION 5

After creating a NBU-Catalog type backup policy, an administrator receives the following message:

```
DR file is on the same partition as your catalog and will be unusable in an actual disaster or disk failure.
```

Which two options are available to the administrator to ensure the DR file is available for future use? (Choose two.)

- A. ensure the folder DR file is on a non-root volume.
- B. ensure the DR file is created on a volume other than the NetBackup volume.
- C. ensure the NetBackup catalog is on a non-root volume.
- D. configure a valid email address of the administrator in the "Send email" option.
- E. configure Auto Image Replication to send the DR file to a remote master server.
