The company has the departments shown in the following table.

Name	Mailbox location	Number of recipients
Sales	MBX1	300
Production	MBX2	500
Administration	MBX1	200
IT	Exchange Online	50
Managers	Exchange Online	100
Marketing	Exchange Online	350

From the on-premises organization, outbound email is sent directly to the internet by using DNS lookups.

You are informed that some sales department users send email messages that are identified as spam.

You need to automatically block the sales department users from repeatedly sending spam.

Solution: You modify the Send connector to use Exchange Online as a smart host.

Does this meet the goal?

You have a Microsoft Exchange Server 2019 organization that contains a Mailbox server named EX01. EX01 contains a mailbox database named MailDB1.

You attach a new hard drive named F to EX01. On drive F, you create a folder named Databases. You plan to run the following command on EX01.

`Move-DatabasePath`

Correct Answer:

You discover that users rarely delete items from their Sent Items folder and their Deleted Items folder.

Does this meet the goal?

Correct Answer: B

This could work but the personal tags would need to use the 'Permanently Delete' option and the users would have to assign the tags to their Sent Items folder and their Deleted Items folders.

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**QUESTION 10**

Your network contains an Active Directory domain named contoso.com.

You have a Microsoft Exchange Server 2019 organization for contoso.com that has two Internet-facing servers named EX01 and EX02.

In the public DNS zone, you have two MX records for contoso.com.

You discover that all email sent to the organization is delivered to EX01. However, when EX01 is down for maintenance, email messages are delivered successfully to EX02.

You need to ensure that email is delivered to both EX01 and EX02 during normal operations.

What should you modify?

- A. the priority of the MX records
- B. the properties of the Receive connector on EX01

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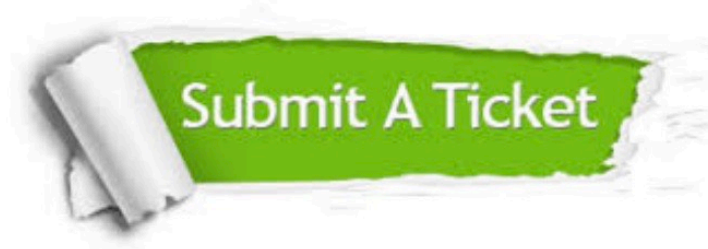
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
